

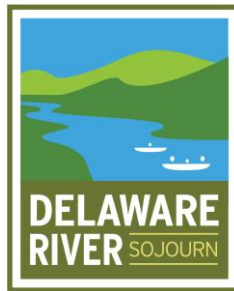

- Saturday, June 17: Zane Grey Museum to Corwin Farm/NPS Office (6 mi)
- Sunday, June 18: Pond Eddy, N.Y. to Port Jervis, N.Y. (10 mi)
- Monday, June 19: Dingmans, Pa. to Bushkill, Pa. (10.4 mi)
- Tuesday, June 20: Bushkill, Pa. to Worthington State Forest, N.J. (12.8 mi)
- Wednesday, June 21: Lehigh River: Rt. 33 Access to Island Park (8 mi)
- Thursday, June 22: Martins Creek Access, Pa. to Easton, Pa. (10.6 mi)
- Friday, June 23: Easton, Pa. to Riegelsville, N.J. (8.5 mi)
